Decision item 2.4: Adoption of the short-term resource mobilization and outreach actions

The Steering Committee

- Adopts the short-term resource mobilization and outreach actions as submitted on the 28th September;
- Requests the SOFF Secretariat to submit additional short term actions for upcoming Steering Committee meetings, as needed, and to keep track of the progress related to the short term actions and update the Steering Committee accordingly.

In order to translate the SOFF Resource Mobilization and Outreach Strategy into short-term action, the Steering Committee requests:

- its co-chairs to send letters on their behalf and at earliest convenience to selected potential funders, requesting them to consider a financial contribution to the SOFF UNMPTF. The Steering Committee also requests the SOFF Secretariat to provide recommendations as to which funders should be targeted and to support the issuance of these letters.
- the SOFF Secretariat to seek SOFF membership in the Insuresilience Global Partnership and to represent SOFF in it.
- the SOFF Secretariat to develop collaboration notes between SOFF and the multilateral climate and environment funds represented in the SOFF Advisory Board (Adaptation Fund, Climate Investment Fund, Green Climate Fund, Global Environment Facility) as well as the Climate Risks and Early Warning Systems initiative (CREWS) and to present these notes for Steering Committee endorsement at the fifth SOFF Steering Committee.
- the SOFF Secretariat to prepare a SOFF communications plan for endorsement at the fourth SOFF Steering Committee and create a SOFF dedicated website to be launched at the occasion of the fourth SOFF Steering Committee meeting.
- the SOFF Secretariat to act as the representative of the SOFF UNMPTF in UNFCCC processes, events and related meetings, including through SOFF submissions and participation in Subsidiary Bodies and COP sessions open to observers. It further requests the SOFF Secretariat to consult with the Steering Committee co-chairs on the specifics of this involvement. It also requests the SOFF Secretariat to represent SOFF in the events related to the Sharm El-Sheikh work programme on the Global Goal on Adaptation, including the upcoming virtual meeting on 17-18 October.
- its members to endeavor positioning systematic observation, GBON and SOFF in the UNFCCC COP27 decisions outcomes.
- WMO, which has been tasked by the UN Secretary-General to spearhead actions related to the UN Early Warnings for All Initiative, to prominently position SOFF as the foundational element of this initiative.
