SOFF Implementation Progress As of 2 June 2023

1. Context

On the 30th of March 2023, the Steering Committee approved the funding requests for 26 countries, of which 14 countries are part of the initial priority countries of the UN Early Warnings for All Initiative (see Table 2). After approval, the peer advisors signed Assignment Agreements to kick off the implementation of the readiness activities in the countries. 16 peer advisors and 7 implementing entities are engaged in the implementation of the Readiness phase in these countries. The portfolio of SOFF Readiness phase under implementation is shown below.

2. Readiness phase progress overview

The Readiness phase in the 26 countries shows overall satisfactory progress, with only minor issues within the control of the peer advisors and beneficiary countries. There were no reports of increasing risks or foreseen difficulties impeding the timely delivery of the Readiness phase outputs in this group of 26 countries.




Figure 1. Progress of SOFF Readiness Phase Portfolio.

21 countries are fully on track to deliver the Readiness outputs as stated in the Funding Requests. Three countries face delays due to a long process of signing the legal agreements and other related formalities. The peer advisor is expecting to sign the agreements soon. Two additional countries have slight delays in implementation but are expecting to be able to deliver the outputs as planned. 25 out of the 26 countries requested to conduct the Country Hydromet Diagnostics. Figure 1 shows the progress update as reported by the peer advisors.

3. Expected delivery of Readiness phase outputs

Based on the progress reported by the peer advisors and the timelines indicated in the funding requests, 21 countries have planned to complete the Readiness Phase by September 2023 and some of them could potentially already submit an Investment Phase funding request for consideration at the 6th Steering Committee Meeting in November 2023 (see Table 2).
